Items in the monthly box include: canned fruit, vegetables, meat, cereal, juice, and cheese

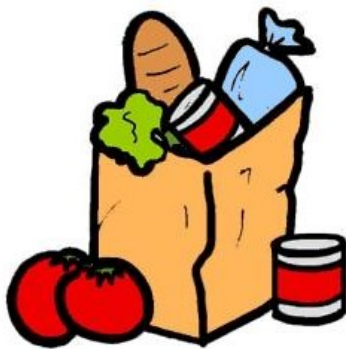

Who can receive CSFP?

- Residents of Charleston, Beaufort, Berkeley, Georgetown, Horry, or Williamsburg counties.
- 60 years of age or older
- Must meet the income guidelines created by USDA

How to apply:

- Contact or visit your local distribution site
- Complete CSFP application at site
- **Provide proof of income (pay stub, Social Security statement)**
- **Provide proof of age (ID)**
- **Provide proof of address (ID, bill)**
